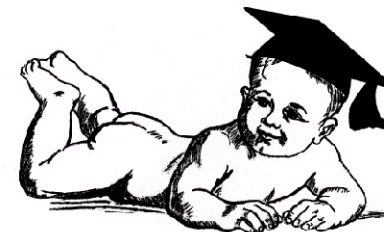

What is the value of the scholarship?

- \* There are no fixed amounts. It will vary with the availability of funds and the qualifications of the applicants.

Who is eligible?

- \* Students age 17 and older who have AANR affiliation and/or experience.
- \* Winners of AANR regional scholarships will be considered for additional funds.

What are the applicant's responsibilities?

- \* Completing an application form.
- \* Completing the essay questions.
- \* Getting two recommendations. (see below)
- \* Arranging for an official transcript.
- \* Seeing that all of the above are postmarked on or before May 31 of the application year.

What Recommendations are needed?

- \* A letter of academic recommendation from a teacher, school counselor or administrator on his/her own school stationery.
- \* A letter of personal recommendation from a person of authority in the applicant's local community (employer, volunteer organization, etc.) on his/her letterhead.
- \* It is strongly suggested that the applicant provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope for these to be mailed directly to the AANR Education Foundation.
